Time:

Classes begin at 8:00 a.m. Please plan on arriving by 7:45 a.m. and pick up at 3:15 p.m. for both Middle School students and Upper School students.

Location:

Drop-off and pick-up is in the Admissions Office in Cuddy Hall, the middle school building. Parking is available on College Street.

What to wear:

There is no specific dress code for visitors. We ask that you simply wear something comfortable and tasteful. Jeans are acceptable. No short skirts/shorts or shirts without sleeves.

What to expect:

Visitors will be paired with a Cavalier Ambassador host for the day, attending all of their regular classes, including lunch and other meetings or assemblies that may take place on that day. Our special guests will receive a free food pass for break and lunchtime.

For parents:

While your student is shadowing, parents are welcome to take a tour of campus. Tours can be arranged with the Admissions Office.
